# The 24th Australian Selective Achievement Test (ASAT)

## (Sunday, 13th January 2019)

The 24<sup>th</sup> ASAT has been confirmed to be held on **Sunday, 13<sup>th</sup> January 2019**. It will be the last ASAT test for the students who will sit for the Selective High Schools Placement Test on 14<sup>th</sup> March 2019.

The ASAT is superior to other practice exams in producing up-to-date questions and implementing exam information upgrades parallel to that of the actual selective school exam.

**Participation** in the ASAT provides an opportunity for students to gain a measure of their current achievement level under the same exam conditions as an actual exam.

It will greatly help parents to review their current school choices in their selective high school application. Reports will provide the estimated profile score and rank as well as other information about averages and levels of achievement.
