## OC Trial Test Course (OCTTC)

Pre-uni New College's Opportunity Class Trial Test Course (OCTTC) is significant for students who intend to sit for the OC Placement Test. This course is specifically designed for Year 4 students in 2019 and consists of weekly tests which assess knowledge and performance under exam conditions. By sitting OC Trial Tests, students systematically revise the entire course and can be confidently prepared for the OC Placement Test on Wednesday, 31<sup>st</sup> July 2019.

The OCTTC is unique as it allows students to practise exam style questions under exam conditions. While the answer sheets are being marked, teachers review the entire test paper with particular focus on difficult questions. Students receive their individual results at the end of each session as a record of their performance. The OCTTC will help your child to manage his or her time efficiently, minimise errors, overcome examination nerves and perform at his or her optimum level under exam conditions.

This course will assist children to develop their narrative, descriptive, persuasive and explanatory writing skills so they can become proficient writers across all key learning areas.

Throughout this course, students will learn how to develop and improve their skills in:

- \* Use effective vocabulary      \* Spelling                      \* Punctuation                      \* Sentence structure

The aim of this course is to target students' individual needs in writing so they can become more confident, capable and proficient writers.

It will assist students with their individual performance in all written tasks in the classroom as well as formalised tests such as NAPLAN and UNSW competitions.
