Before & After Care - Free Self-Study Class

For our busy working parents, the Strathfield Head Office will **open from 8:00am** during the winter holiday course period. Parents can drop off their child at the head office before they start working.

After the class, students may attend our free self-study class **until 5:00pm** and do their homework or read their books under tutors' supervision. Parents are required to book for the self-study class in advance.

Year 6 Maths, Debating & Speech Course (8 ~ 12 July 2019)

This course covers essential skills required for high school studies. During the maths session, students will revise and consolidate the following topics: the number plane, algebra, fractions, decimals, percentages, geometry, area, volume and probability. The debating and speech session will provide the opportunity for student to learn, practise and enhance their public speaking and debating skills. Students will prepare and present a range of oral presentations as well as research, prepare and participate in a debate.

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Year 6 Critical Reading & Writing Course (15 ~ 19 July 2019)

The writing session of this course is designed to develop skills in analysing and composing narratives and adapting multimedia to informative and persuasive writing. Students will explore a range of texts and focus on practising the skills necessary to produce the best possible writing.

Critical reading means being able to reflect on what a text says, what it describes and what it means by scrutinising the style and structure of the writing, the language used as well as the content. During the reading session, students will analyse a variety of texts and text types to help them to develop and master their reading comprehension skills, to prepare them for Year 7 as well as NAPLAN. Students will examine a variety of text types such as narrative, articles, reports, advertisements, poems and persuasive texts.
