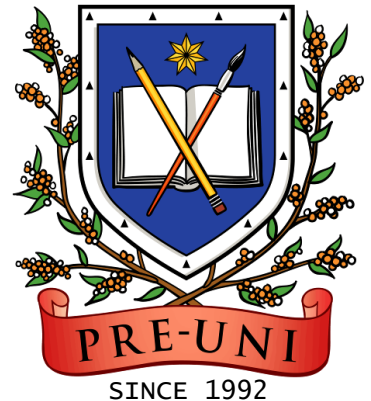

The fundamental logic behind these Spring Holiday Workshops is to provide students with opportunities to develop and enhance the integral skills required for success in Highschool. The workshops will also allow students to clear any doubts from previous term topics and get ahead for the upcoming terms in school.

Year 8 Maths Workshop 29 Sep – 3 Oct [9:00-12:00]

This Mathematics Master class will focus on building student confidence and expertise in mathematics and facilitate faster mental problem-solving to ensure accuracy and speed in their final exams. Through revisiting these topics, students are able to dismantle any remaining gaps in their knowledge and develop a wholistic understanding of how each topic connects.


The topics being covered include; Angle Relationships, Area and Volumes (including Circles), Rates / Ratios / Time / Speed, Linear Equations, Algebraic Techniques / Indices / Factorisation and Coordinate Geometry

Stage 4 Writing Workshop 29 Sep – 3 Oct [13:00-16:00]

In this 5-day course on textual analysis, students begin with an exploration of prose fiction, learning active reading strategies and delving into the TEE structure (technique, example, effect) for effective text analysis. They'll engage in hands-on activities, like visualizing imagery from quotes and deducing deeper meanings. The course then shifts to poetry, emphasizing both figurative language and structural elements. Literary techniques are meticulously broken down, with a special focus on common writing mistakes and best practices for integrating textual evidence
