

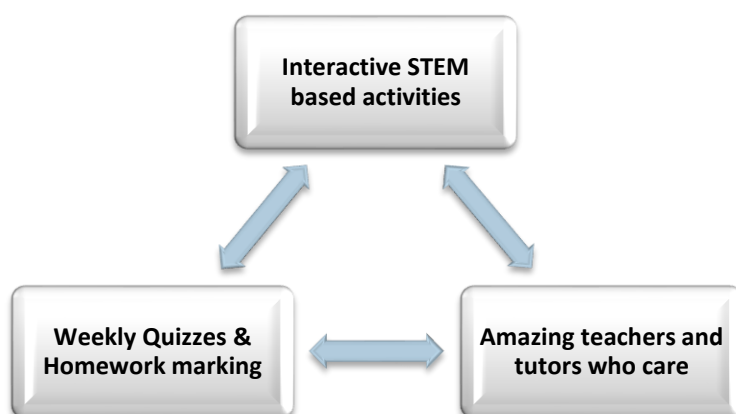


2026 Year 10 Term 3 English Course (18 July – 27 September)

Homework Marking

We provide weekly homework marking (self-marking for Maths) & video lesson service that provides an opportunity for review and reinforcement of skills that have been mastered and encourages practicing skills that are not. Homework also is an opportunity for children to learn self-discipline and organizational skills and to take responsibility for their own learning.

We encourage parents to regularly check homework progress with their child. A quick conversation about what they found challenging can be very helpful in identifying ongoing weaknesses or areas of struggle early.

1:1 Tutoring (Booking is required)

These sessions are ideal for revising difficult topics and addressing individual learning needs. We strongly encourage families to book in and make full use of this support. Both face-to-face and online options are available.
